

CHUN CHIEH CHANG

Biography

Chun-Chieh Chang is an artist who was diagnosed with hearing impairment at an early age. Chun-Chieh was invited to participate in many group exhibitions during university. Chun-Chieh was interviewed by television and newspapers in Taiwan inspiring other students with impaired hearing with his story.

Most of his works are now in the collection of public and private institutes and hotels include オークラプレステージ台北(The Okura Prestige Taipei), Taiwan Research Institute of Arts, Kaohsiung, private collection in Taiwan. Chun-Chieh also obtained a scholarship from University and other foundations include Special Education Student Scholarship and Li-Ming Cultural Enterprise Foundation.

In October 2016, Chun-Chieh was invited to give a lecture on his artwork with Sam Tsai from MUZE architecture/space/interior design, a private organization. The presentation was about the creative concept behind the work and how to connect interior spaces with artworks.

In 2018, Chun-Chieh studying at the School of Visual Arts, New York. He is possibly the first hearing impaired student from Taiwan to pursue an MFA at the School of Visual Arts and receive Taiwan ministry of education Studying Abroad Scholarship, His expected graduation is May 2020.
